#### **❖** Regular Membership Meeting ❖

- The Fall Meeting of the Malvern Club will be held on Saturday, October 21st, in the Clubhouse. Sign-in will start at 9:00 am. The meeting will start at 10:00 am. Meetings usually end by noon.
- Members will be asked to approve the <u>minutes</u> of the 2023 Annual Membership Meeting held on April 29, 2023.
- Members will be asked to approve the Board's proposed 2024 Budget. You may look over the budget before hand in the Fall Communicator, which will be mailed to all members the week of October 1st.
- At the meeting, the Board will present options for renovating the front patio at the Clubhouse. So far, the Board has received proposals for a stamped concrete patio from the driveway up to the house and down the portico behind the Activity Center. We will also be installing a sidewalk leading to the Pool Restroom and continuing up to the portico for wheelchair access.

# Pool News

- The pool will remain open for as long as the weather stays warm but will close no sooner than 10:00 pm, Sunday, September 10th.
- We had to have the pool service contractor come out and clear out the vacuum pipe. This is the open hole in the wall of the pool in the shallow end. The pipe was full of gravel and other debris. One of our Board members saw some kids bringing gravel rocks into the pool area last week and quite a few of them were sucked up into the pipe by the vacuum hose. The old newspaper boxes have been repurposed as USPS parcel lockers that are larger than our existing ones. These boxes will become operational once the Post Office installs the key holes.
